Objectives

 Replace its non-standardised systems with a solution that was integrated with its ERP (from SAP) and Manufacturing Execution System (Plant Apps from GE) for complex scheduling issues in producing, slitting, metalising and converting high performance films

Implemented Solutions

- X-Trim addresses primarily film line and the metallisation step
- opt-Studio schedules all production stages

Benefits

- Optimised the geometry, metallisation and the scheduling
- Integrating trimming of metallisers simultaneously with the film lines and base film inventory has resulted in an improvement in yield
- Integrated trim process allows the scheduler to plan more closely to the targeted quantities, reducing overrun and minimising customer shipment errors
- Reduction in paperwork and improved communication through visibility of operations schedule being available online and updated in real time
